Dear Parents/Carers and Families,

As we reach the end of the fourth week, the nights are growing longer and we are beginning to feel Autumn creeping in. The weather is unpredictable as always, so please keep bringing those raincoats in – even if it's sunny! We've had another lovely week with lots going on, and lots to look forward to:

# **The Library Bus**

On Tuesday we had a visit from The Library Bus! This travelling library spent the whole afternoon at our school, and a representative from each class was given the opportunity to get on board and browse the collection. Each class took away 20 borrowed books for their classroom reading corners – we are very grateful for such a wonderful opportunity!

# **Harvest Collection for the Mid-Cheshire Foodbank**

If you were here last year, you may remember our hugely successful collection for the Mid-Cheshire Food Bank over Harvest. We made a massive donation of essentials, thanks to the good will of all our families, and once again, the food bank have made a call for help.

Between April 2022 and March 2023, Mid-Cheshire Food Bank supplied 3,457 food parcels. 52% of the households accepting these were accessing the food bank for the first time. Each parcel had at least 5 days of food, including fresh fruit and veg, bread and eggs – that is 44,650 days' worth of food, 133,950 meals, or enough food to feed 1 person for 122 years! Every weekday, they distribute 480kg of food - equivalent to the weight of a Highland Cow. These figures are not reducing, and inevitably, the donations received are barely keeping pace with the demand as the cost of living bites into household budgets. The generosity of the community at times like Harvest are vital for the food bank, ensuring they can meet the ongoing demand for help.

We have decided once again to hold a collection at school. This will take place during the last two weeks of term, from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> October to Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> October. Attached to this email is a list of items that the food bank currently requires the most, as these are the items that they are short of. We will have trolleys available during the collection times for you to drop off donations; please avoid bringing items into the office or into school before the collection window opens.

## **Early Years: Come Dine With Us!**

Today was an important day for Early Years as we put on our annual Come Dine With Us event. Parents and carers have been into school to share lunch with the children and to get a taste of what lunchtime life is like for our youngest cohort.

No payment is needed; this is a free visit.

# **Midday Assistant Vacancy**

We currently have two vacancies for a Midday Assistant to join our school team. The midday shift runs between 11.45am and 1.30pm, 5 days a week, 8.75 hours a week; it involves ensuring the safety and welfare of all children during the lunchtime period, in addition to helping maintain a safe and fun environment in the dinner hall and outside play areas. The person will also be involved in setting up the lunch hall and supervising the behaviour of the children.
