Year 5 Visit to Jodrell Bank

Next Tuesday 5th March, Year 5 are visiting Jodrell Bank. The visit will start their learning from the science topic of 'Earth and Space' and their English topic using the texts 'The Darkest Dark' by astronaut, Chris Hadfield and our non-fiction guided reading text on The International Space Station. Whilst there, the children will take a guided tour of the Solar System and discover constellations in Jodrell Bank's Space Dome. The children will also have time to explore the numerous interactive exhibits available at the site, including learning how the Lovell Telescope views the Universe and about the live science taking place at this UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Year 4 Swimming

These lessons are part of the curriculum and ensure that all the children have access to a pool and lessons in water safety.
