#### Year 4 Visits to Lion Salt Works - 22<sup>nd</sup> April 4LO and 25<sup>th</sup> April 4MH

Year 4 went on a very enjoyable trip to the Salt Museum this week. They learnt all about how salt used to be extracted as brine from the ground all around the Northwich area and the effect it had on the surrounding buildings. They also carried out a number of experiments to investigate what salt is, including mixing it with fizzy pop to create a mini explosion! The children enjoyed the experience very much and the whole day went incredibly quickly.

# Year 5 Northwich Sings – Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> May

Next Thursday Year 5 will be performing "Wind in the Willows", a musical by Mark and Helen Johnson, along with their peers from Cuddington, Little Leigh, Sandiway and Witton Church Walk Primary Schools. This is a fabulous opportunity for the children to take part in an event with other schools in our Trust and as part of the Northwich Education Partnership.

# Year 5 Visit to Chester Zoo – Tuesday 7th May

Year 5 also have a trip to Chester Zoo to look forward to on 7<sup>th</sup> May. The visit will consolidate their learning from their Science topic of Living Things and their Habitats and also their English topic of the Environment and Conservation. Whilst there, the children will have the opportunity to take part in a walking tour workshop - studying some of the different habitats at Chester Zoo. They will observe common characteristics of animals in order to classify them, decide on an animal's relative position in a food chain by determining the function of its teeth and compare lifecycles of some of the zoo animals. It promises to be a fun and interesting way to find out about the animals that live there.
