## A Sporting Update from Mr Cairns

Football - On 15<sup>th</sup> March 10 very excited boys headed off to Liverpool FC Academy to take part in the North Final. The winners from every county in the North of England were there so the standard was high.

With Liverpool 1<sup>st</sup> team training in the distance, the boys started with a 0-0 draw followed by a win against the champions of Durham. Another win against the Cumbria team saw us in 2<sup>nd</sup> place and on course to make the semifinals. A loss in the 4<sup>th</sup> game meant it was all to play for going into the final set of games. The boys played their best match and won 3-1. Unfortunately, other results did not go their way and they finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in the group. They missed out on the semi-finals by one point. Tom, Lucas, Owen, Rafferty, Cooper, Max, Jacob, Isaac, Elliott, and Connor are the most successful team we have had at Hartford and should be very proud of their performances this season.

The Basketball County Final was played on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> March. It was a very physical contest with the ball being slapped and wrestled out of the children's hands at every opportunity. To prevent this, Hartford went back to playing a netball style game moving the ball very quickly around the court. Izzy, Bea, Olivia, Abbie, Max, and Lucas played very well on the day, winning four matches, and losing three. They missed out on the medals by one point but should be very happy with how they played.

The same children plus Tilly then headed off to Macclesfield to the Netball County Final on Wednesday. After a 5-4 loss to eventual winners Alderley Edge in the first game, they went on a 5-game winning streak. They worked well as a team and stuck to the tactics that had got them through the first two tournaments. A loss in the final match to Childer Thornton led to a tense wait to see where they would finish in the table. A joint-second place finish saw the children come home with well-deserved medals and big smiles on their faces.
